How To get there:

We have **TWO** options for parking and your trip to the location on the trail where the dedication will occur.

Please plan to arrive at your parking area with plenty of time to walk or ride to the tunnel so that we may begin promptly at 6:00p.m.

Directional signage for the event will be placed at key turnoffs.

From Johnstown and points east:

Take Rt. 22 West past Blairsville to Rt. 981 at New Alexandria Turn Right onto Rt. 981 North. Follow for approximately 6 miles and turn right onto Tunnelton Road. Follow Tunnelton Road toward the Conemaugh Dam, turning left when the road comes to a T with Pump Station Road.

Parking option (A)

Follow Tunnelton Road past Auen Road and look for the Game Commission parking area on the left. Parking is available at the Tunnelton Road Game Commission parking area. It is approximately 3000 feet from the parking area to the tunnel, or a ## minute bike ride; ## minute walk.

Parking option (B)

There a few are additional parking spaces farther down this access road toward the tunnel for those who might prefer a 500 foot walk to the tunnel.
